### **School Advisory Council Meetings**

Thanks to the parents who came out to the October meeting. Our principal Cheryl Patterson gave a report on school issues. The results of the EQAO standardized tests are now published. At McKee, the percentage of students performing above the provincial standards was higher than that across the board in all three of the areas tests: reading, writing and math. Congratulations to our students and teachers. The school budget was also presented. This year, a large portion of the money from the school board will be used to update our technology, replace computers and to maintain/expand the library collection. You can find out more when the minutes are published on our website (it appears shortly before the next meeting). The SAC executive presented our budget proposal for this school year. Parents voted in favour of this budget which will see the SAC continue pizza lunches and selling snacks as well as taking on the Dance-a-thon. The funds raised from these activities will support two worthy school programs: Prologue to the performing arts and Scientist in the School. Parents also voted to allocate some money toward defraying the costs of field trips. Our next meeting will be held on Tuesday, November 23, 2010 at 6:30 p.m. in the staff room. As usual, food is provided and, for those who need it, there is a babysitter for every meeting. N.B. Parents in attendance will not be charged parking fees.
