Playground

A big topic at the SAC meetings this year will be improvements to the playground. Those who are new to the McKee community may not realize that a few short years ago, the field was not covered in woodchips but was mud when it rained and dust when it was dry. This condition left most of the outdoor space unusable in wet or windy weather. The administration has worked hard with the TDSB to cover the mud with woodchips and to place turf (grass) on half of the field. This means that our children can enjoy the field in almost all weather.

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Last year, a "playground committee" was formed. The members included staff representatives, a student representative, 2 parents, a landscape architect and TDSB Grounds employees. The committee explored several iterations of the playground design and the final playground design was posted near the office.

At the end of June, the administration and the SAC contributed \$25,000 to the playground trust fund to purchase and instal additional playscape equipment, 2 tri-hoops and 8 trees. It is our hope that these will be installed before the winter.

We encourage all parents to come and hear the latest in McKee's efforts to improve our kids' playspace. If you are a JK/SK parent, your children may not make it over to the "big kids" playground much this year but they will in the coming years. Please come and get involved!

Fundraising

Our biggest fundraiser at McKee is the Pizza Lunch that happens just about every 2 weeks.
